Overview



- GSA Managed Service Office provides FIPS201 certified credential services to share-holder agencies to meet the requirements of HSPD-12
- 42 Agencies, Boards, and Commissions are onboard with the GSA process. Confirmed population is 550K government employees and contractors **(More Coming!)**
- 40+ Enrollment stations in NCR by September, first installed this week
- Credentialing to commence August 2007
- Service goal is to credential all by October 2008

Credential Technology + Service



The MSO provides **225 'CORE' Credentialing Centers** with a supporting IDMS to support 550,000 credentials. The 225 Credential stations are broken down in **100 Credentialing centers with 1 year of Staffing**, **100 Credentialing centers without staffing**, and **25 Mobile stations without staffing**. The contract includes the costs to move the mobile stations up to 8 times during the year. The cost of this 'CORE' Service in part makes up the cost of the seat price. All 225 'CORE' Credentialing centers are shared and will be utilized either in MSO furnished and staffed facilities or by agencies who host a Credentialing Center. Staffing of Credentialing Centers is a cost factor for the overall seat price as is MSO leasing facilities for shared Credentialing Centers. Those agencies who volunteer to host or to provide staffing will mitigate the seat price for everyone. The job of the MSO is to coordinate the movement of stations to meet the needs of all members of the shared credentialing effort.

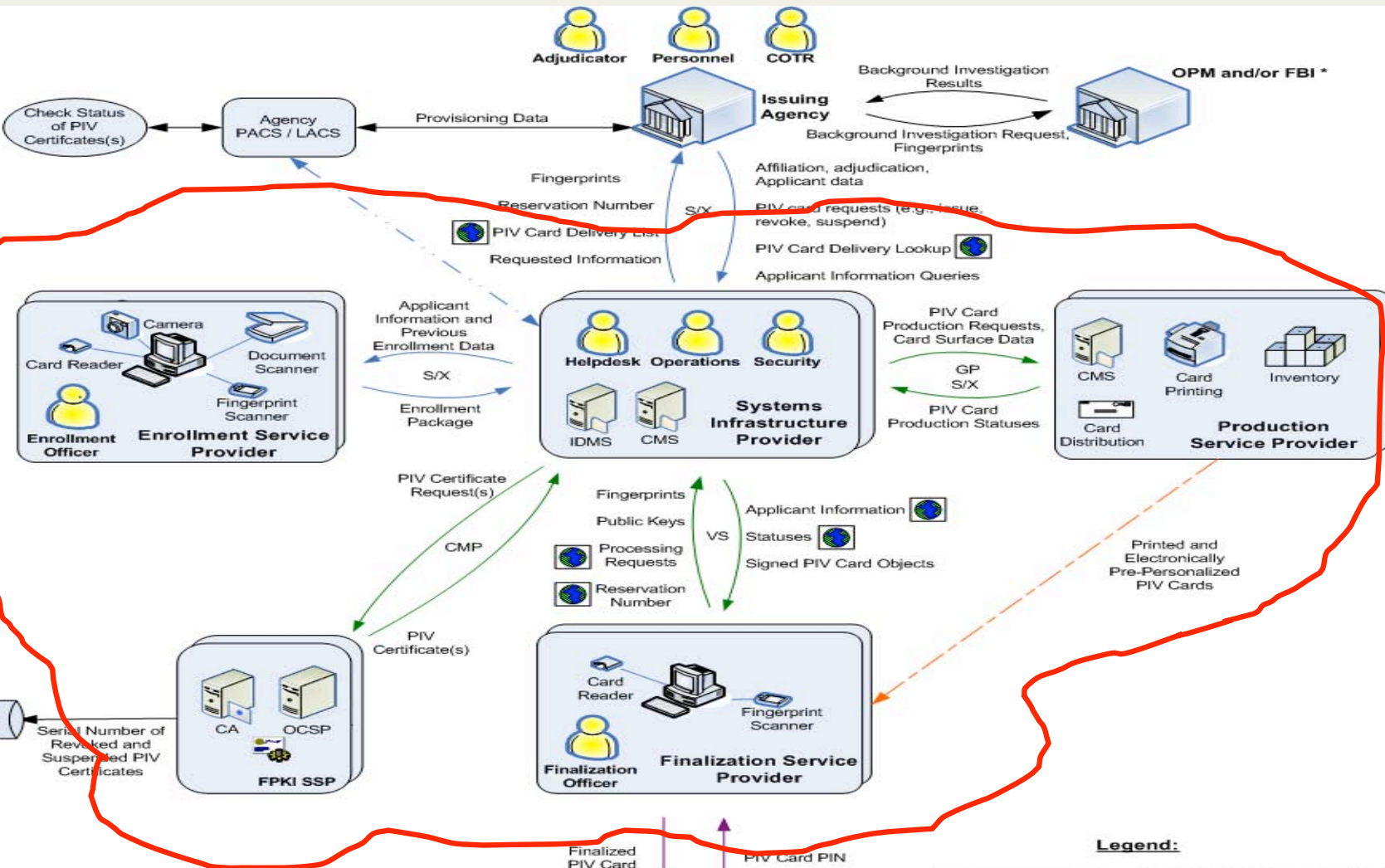
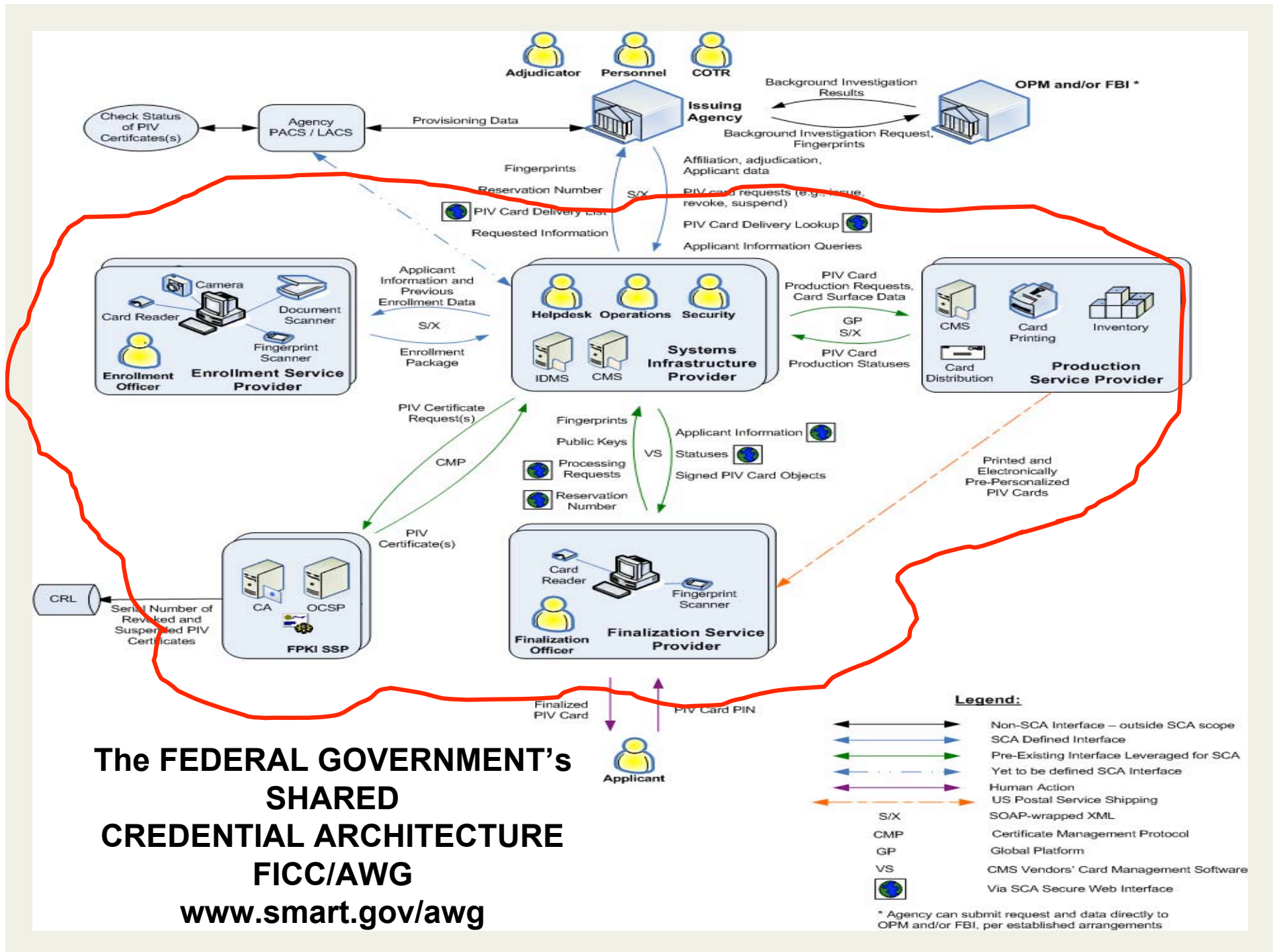


- Raising the technical bar:

 - Post-issuance capability – updates at your workstation
 - Options for unattended activation
 - Implementing the standard interfaces defined by the government in FICC AWG (a first)

Status

- All MSO Milestones completed on time
- System assembly completed 13 July ... initial role cards Friday
- Challenge is loading customer configurations
 - Have initial proof-customizing for each agency for artwork.
 - Optional fields
 - PKI configuration
- MSO to OPM fingerprint interface design complete(6/14), tested 7/12. MSO provides a database 'store and forward' schema for transfer of fingerprints to OPM
- Meeting of Personnel Security Reps (7/16)
 - Lead by SMEs from Energy and Treasury to define configuration and load.
- Pricing approved with Assistant Commissioner (6/8)
- GSA Administrator briefed 6/20
- Blue Tops Weekly
- HR database testing test with USDA commenced last week
- Credentialing commences upon completion of C&A and customer configuration load.
