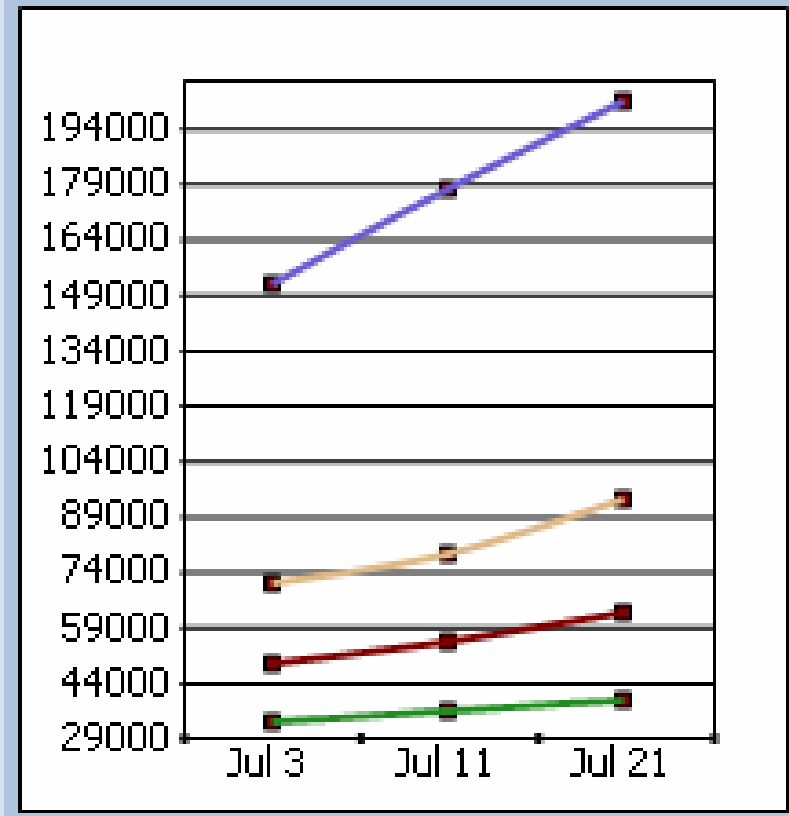

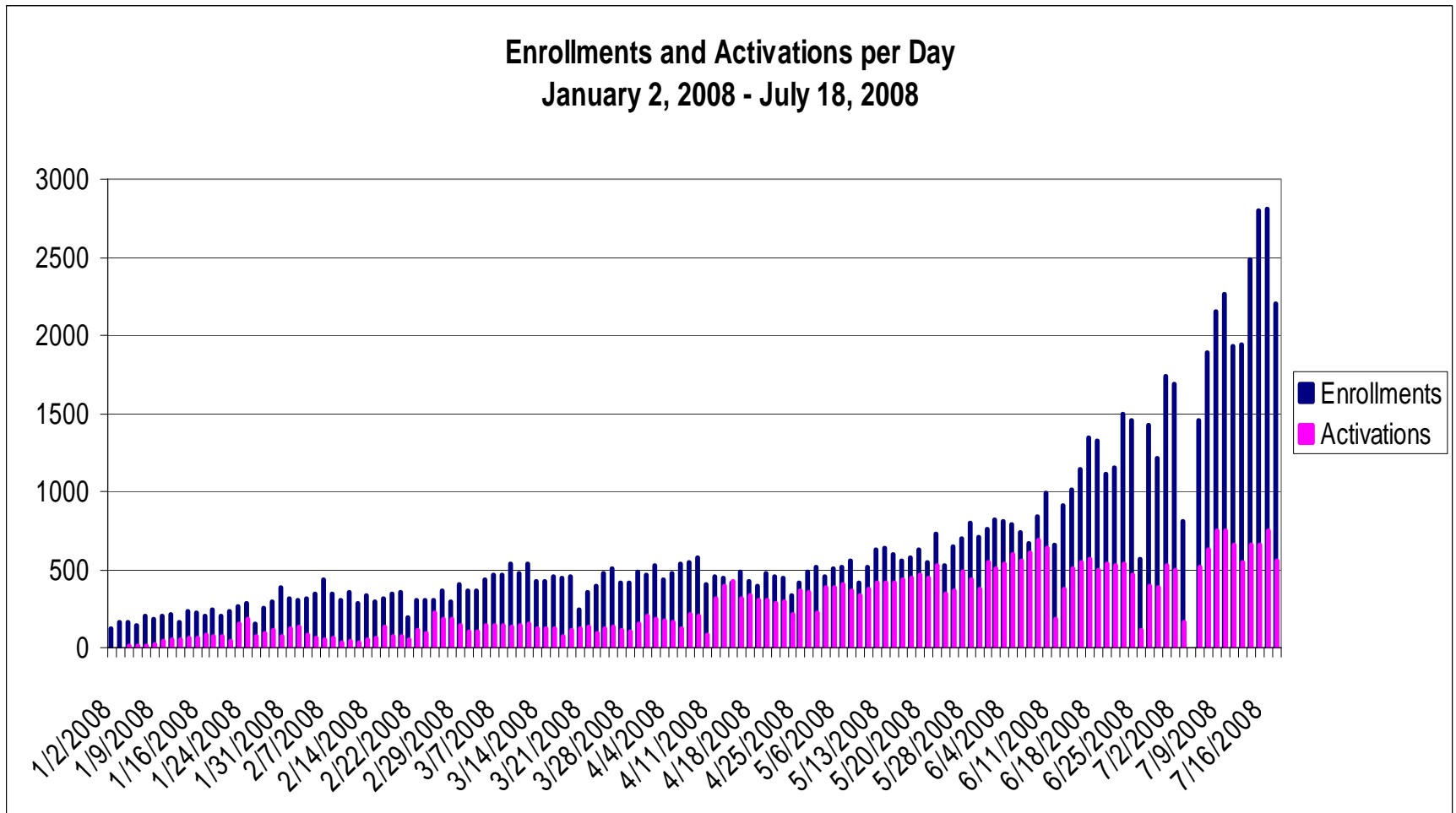

Much has been accomplished in the past few months.

- Established User Group to provide forum for customer agency and MSO interaction
- Management Reporting System streamlines and simplifies financial management processes
- Integration of alternate PKI into the MSO provided Smartcard
- Development of an interface allowing submission of electronic fingerprints directly to OPM

Program Priorities

- Further enhance role administration/scope
- Operationalize OPM interface
- Implement capability to automatically resend emails to applicants who have not taken action
- Reporting enhancements
