We are off ...

- Commenced enrollments 1 September
- First cards issued ... learning curve ...
 - Nuances with interfaces
 - UPN input
- First two agencies are USDA and GSA with heavy usage
 - Loading configurations for others is a challenge
 - Received 13 configurations in the last week

Other Things ...

- Testing multiple PKI providers ...
 - Ability to change out certificates between providers
- 3 Enrollment Centers Open
 - 2 GSA and 1 USDA
 - Learning curve shows 2 week lag from configuration to enroll
 - Deployment schedule 2 weeks ahead of system schedule
- Credentials tested with 3 different PAC systems and had review for logical access. No issues reported.
- Credential has been tested with First Response Pilot

Enrollment Stations Progress

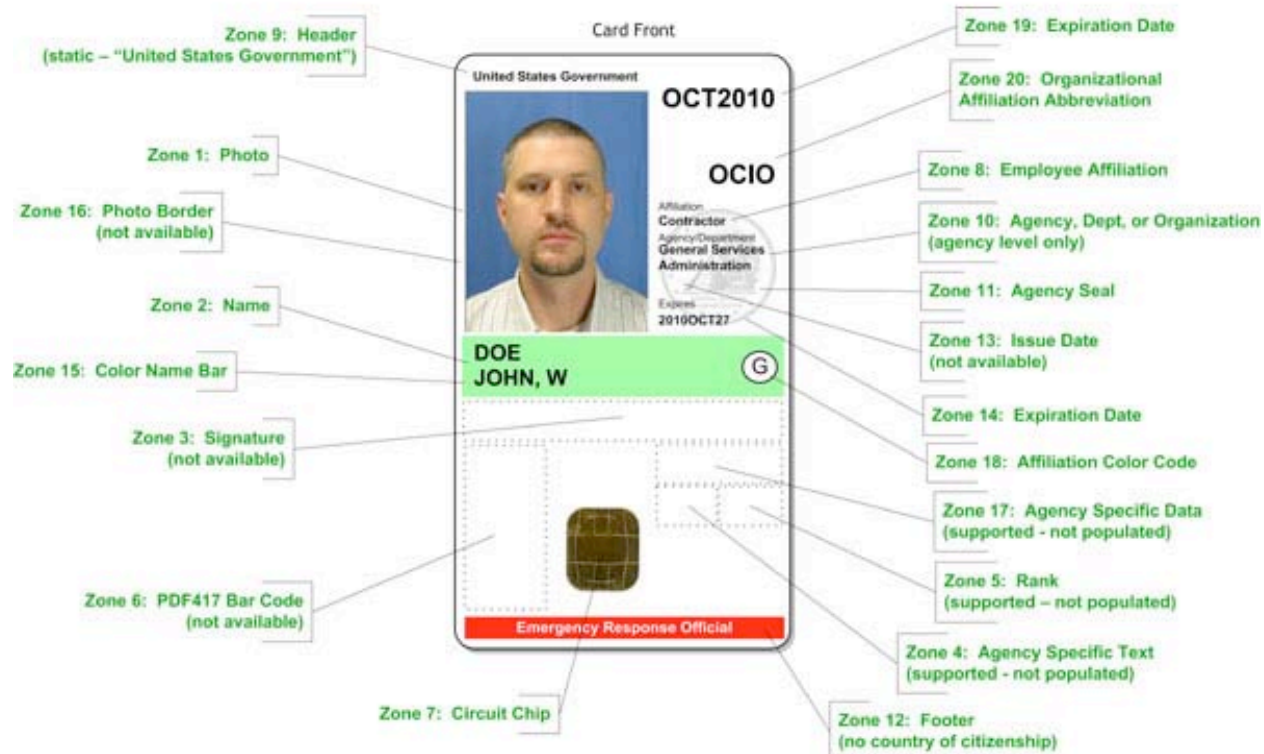
- For the National Capital Region:
 - 15 enrollment machines have been identified as shared stations with customers providing the location for 13 of the machines.
 - 24 enrollment machines have been identified for customers to lease. These enrollment sites will be for the sole use of the leasing customers.
 - 36 have been confirmed to install with the room designated, an agency contact, and a network engineer.
- Defining locations nationwide now.
 - Initial Sites: (USDA and DoE)- Kansas City(MO) , Aiken(GA), Argonne(IL), Amarillo(TX), Paducah(KY), Oak Ridge(TN), Los Alamos(NM), Livermore (CA), Las Vegas(NV)

Deployment

- Three Options:
 - **Shared**- Operators, stations, & site managed by MSO. Must be open to all customers of MSO
 - **Hosted**- Site provided by customer, station by MSO, operator is negotiated. Must be open to all customers of the MSO
 - **Leased**- An Agency leases a station for their own use, they provide the site and the operator. This site can be closed to Agency employees only
- MSO is negotiating with the collective body to identify sites, identify options for each site, and develop a installation schedule. Approximately 60 sites on plan thru October.
