Current State

- SBA HQ enrolling SBA employees and contractors and issuing compliant PIV cards
 - Has issued 212 cards to date, which accounts for 10.10% of SBA HQ personnel
 - Fully compliant technical solution is in place today

- Currently finalizing the plans for deploying the solution to 83 SBA field offices
 - Will leverage mobile issuance platform/capability



General Solution Overview

- SBA utilizes a turnkey solution that is specifically used to support the HSPD-12 and FIPS 201-1 requirements with a strong focus on the efficiency of the Issuance process
- SBA intends to utilize a mix of stationary and mobile enrollment and issuance capabilities as part of the overall solution
 - SBA mobile enrollment capability allows for flexibly registering small business personnel for PIV Card Issuance
 - Implementing the capability to issue 60 PIV Cards **each week** from each stationary SBA site
- SBA is also working in parallel on the PIV Card Usage models
 - Integration with Visitor Management System at SBA HQ
 - SBA employees and contractors will leverage their PIV Cards as the primary security authentication token for accessing the building
 - Planning to Integrate PIV card with the SBA Network
 - Eventually, SBA employees and contractors will leverage their PIV Cards to log into the SBA network



Communities of Interest

- SBA Office of Disaster Assistance (ODA)
 - First Responders
 - Second Responders
 - Third Responders
- SBA Physical Security Services (OM&A)
 - Access to SBA buildings
 - Access to Shared Federal buildings
 - Access to commercial locations and offices
- SBA Logical Security Services (OCIO)
 - Access to the SBA network
 - Remote access to SBA logical resources



Unique Requirement

- Small Businesses make up the majority percentage of commercial capability within the U.S. economy, and in fulfilling responses to disasters, and requirements toward national security.

- SBA is responsible for issuing PIV Cards to personnel that will respond to emergencies, disasters, and other needs for First Responders.

- SBA must have a solution in place that can
 - Rapidly identify known and new small business resources
 - Rapidly authenticate the members of those small businesses
 - Rapidly and flexibly issue PIV Cards to those small business personnel
 - Rapidly and flexibly authorize the PIV Card Holders with physical and logical access to disaster and terror response scenarios in support of Homeland Security efforts
