- ✓ **The October 27th deadline placed the FIPS 201 Configuration in play across the federal enterprise ...**
 - Test Cards: we should expect problems and need to anchor the configuration.
 - Test cards have been requested by the IAB Chair to be forwarded to the GSA lab via David Temoshok.

Issues and Direction

✓ **NEW BUSINESS**

- POLICY ISSUE#1 – Confirmation of Federal Governments support for Contactless Standards ISO 14443 as the course for the FEDERAL Government. Message to industry that other product lines are only acceptable as a migration path. REASON: Industry Associations continue to promote proprietary product lines.
 - TECHNICAL ISSUE#1-BACKEND AUTHENTICATION THROUGH OPM is being worked by an IAB working group. FICC has recommended that this group be officially chartered (decision 13 December). Lead needs to be determined.
 - TECHNICAL ISSUE#2- BIOMETRICS OVER CONTACTLESS has been requested as a working item by the Smartcard Alliance and Federal Agencies. Multiple Groups working issue. Need to decide who has lead.
 - TECHNICAL ISSUE#3-(LONG TERM)-FASC-N number in FIPS needs broader coverage to cover commercial and non-federal agencies.
