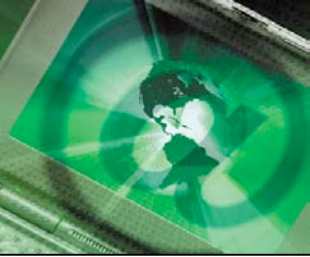

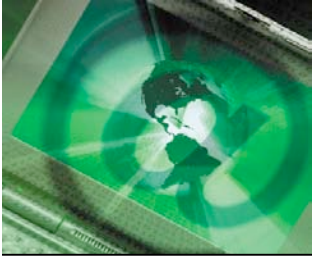

## The GSA Shared Service Initiative

---

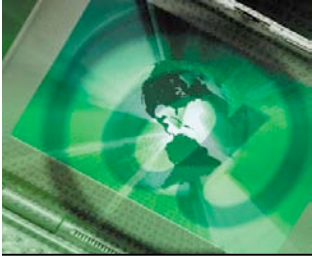
- Contract awarded to BearingPoint on 18 August
- Successful review of 185 HSPD requirements 14 Sept.
  - Town Hall to be held at Main GSA on Sept 21<sup>st</sup>
    - Government only
  - Sept 29<sup>th</sup> is demonstration of full capability
- Initial 4 sites firmed with Public Building Service (Washington, Atlanta, Seattle, New York).
  - Virtually every Agency is with 7 blocks of one of these sites

## What do you get?

---

- ❑ An identity account for each employee with a secure HSPD compliant credential.
  - Four Cybertrust PKI certificates
  - Two fingerprint minutia templates on card
  - Secure backend identity management and card management
  - A share of centrally managed enrollment (including labor)
  - Ability to purchase and manage your own enrollment and a returned cost share
  - Help desk and maintenance support for the credential
  - This will be a manual process (secure web entry) to start



## Status – GSA Shared Services

---

- ❑ Seat count is 400K+ based on verbal commitments and some signed MOUs.
- ❑ Number of agencies that may join is 25+
- ❑ Other agencies outside of Executive Branch have expressed interest.
- ❑ Developing process to start chain of trust
- ❑ Continuing to target mid-October for card issuance

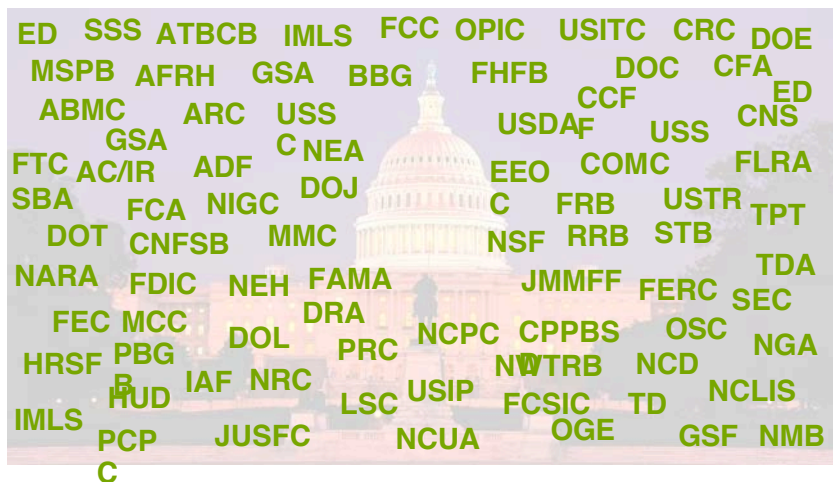
# Agencies Potentially Touched by Initial Rollout
